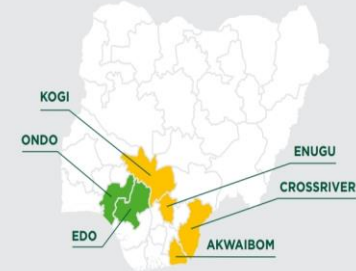

APPROACH

Government-to-government agreement on cooperation relevant to the context of both countries and relevant international agreements like the Paris Agreement

Initiation of national working groups to determine and co-design the Key Performance Goals/Indicators, discuss progress and align with national policy and initiatives

Creation of multi-stakeholder platforms at the province/district level where agreement is reached on climate smart development

Creation of a robust, science-based methodology in country to measure impact

Linking individual & groups of corporate partners to the project through funding & cooperation agreements at smallholder implementation level (landscape scale)



BENEFITS

Strong cooperation and trust between country governments and the creation of a programme that aligns with the national priorities and policies of a country

Intervention embedded in national goals and policy; ownership and contribution to internationally agreed targets (NDCs)

Shared responsibilities between governments, corporates, farmers and millers

A highly adaptable model of cooperation and engagement that can be scaled to other countries and replicated across different commodities.
